




## Strict Products Liability applies if ...

- 1. Product is sold in a defective condition
- 2. By an entity in the regular chain of distribution,
- 3. Which injures a person's body or property







## What counts as a defect?

- Manufacturing defect
- Design defect
- Warning defect
  - (can be thought of as a kind of design defect)

## What makes something defective?

- Being "unreasonably dangerous"
- Tests:
  - Consumer expectations test
  - Risk-utility test

## What counts as an injury?

- To a person's body
- To property
- Not:
  - Pure economic injury, loss of money
  - Emotional distress
  - Reputation
  - Not damage to the product itself
